



Rockland Landing Construction Update

Girder Placement to Temporarily Impact River Road/Piermont Ave.

Tappan Zee Constructors, LLC (TZC) is preparing to install steel girders for the New NY Bridge project at the Rockland Landing. The materials will connect the future westbound span of the new bridge to an on-land abutment. The process will take several months to complete and will impact traffic near the Tappan Zee Bridge on River Road/Piermont Ave. In addition to these operations, additional materials will be delivered to the Rockland work trestle from the New York State Thruway (I-81/I-287) via the northbound and southbound maintenance ramps.



September 24 – November 5

River Road/Piermont Ave. reduced to one lane


During this period, River Road/Piermont Ave. will be reduced to one lane near the Tappan Zee Bridge on weekdays between 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Flag persons will keep traffic moving by alternating directional flow between northbound and southbound traffic. During this time, TZC will utilize large cranes near River Road/Piermont Ave. to install girders between the new bridge's first and second piers east of the roadway.

November 9 – November 18

River Road/Piermont Ave. reduced to one lane, with up to 20-minute traffic stops daily

During this period, weekday lane closures will continue between 6 a.m. and 5 p.m. TZC will also hold traffic on River Road once every weekday at approximately 9 a.m. for up to 20 minutes.

The temporary stops are required to safely install the new bridge's girders over the roadway, as illustrated. Flag persons will be on site to facilitate the lane closings and maintain traffic safety.
