

## Summary report of South Nyack Electronics Waste Collection, Spring 2014

Number of individual residents using the service: **29**

Total number of electronics items collected: **132**

### Most common items:

Television – 28 Computer printer – 13 Stereo – 12 Computer – 11 (See table and charts on next page).

**Advertising methods:** Village newsletter article, village e-mail alert, hand-delivered bi-lingual fliers.

**Cost to village:** DPW staff time for event set up and event participation. Storage container.

**Benefit to village:** Saves DPW staff having to collect individual items from curbside.

**Benefit to environment:** Saves items from being dumped in the landfill. Recycling/re-use of materials.

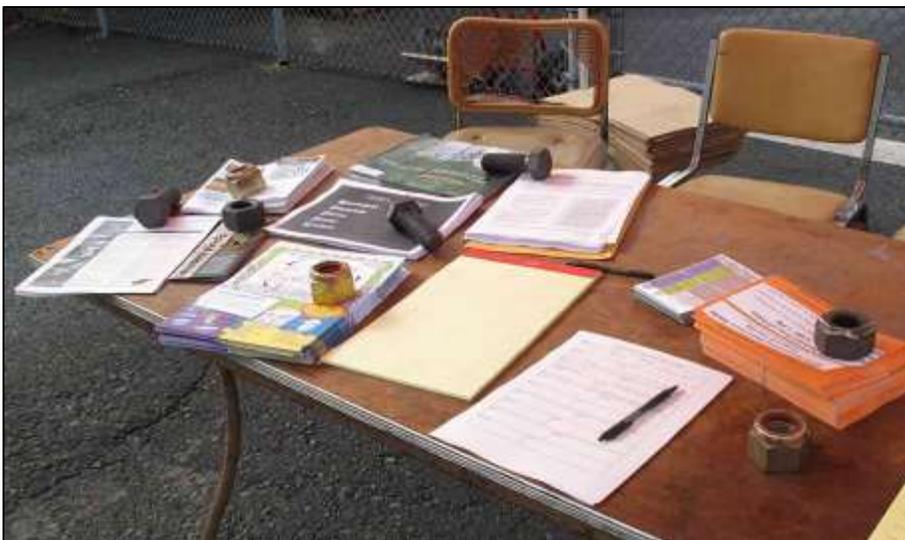
**Benefit to ARC:** Provides employment for county residents with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

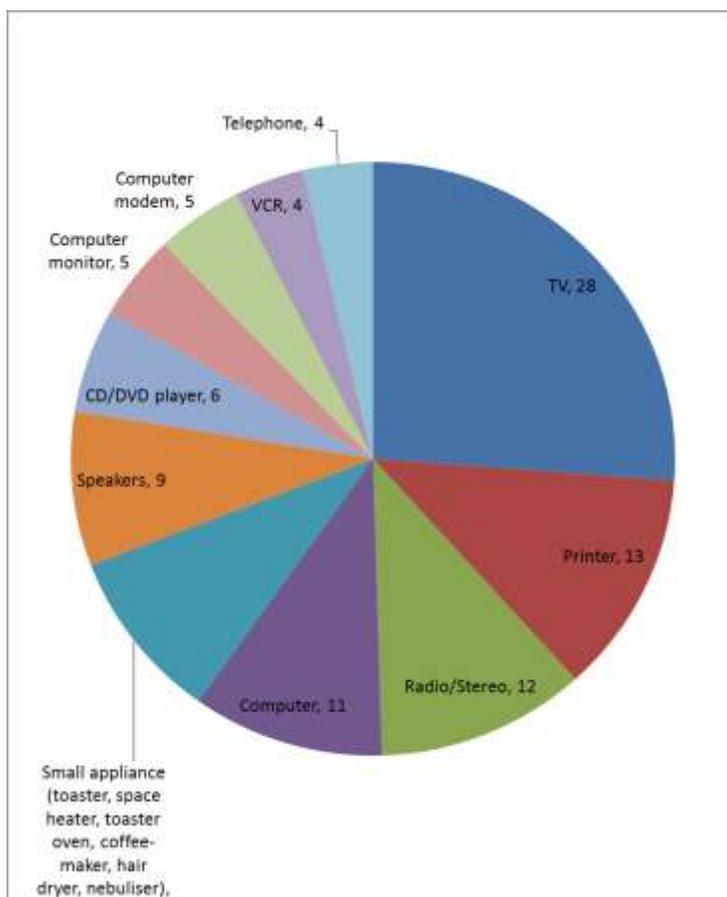
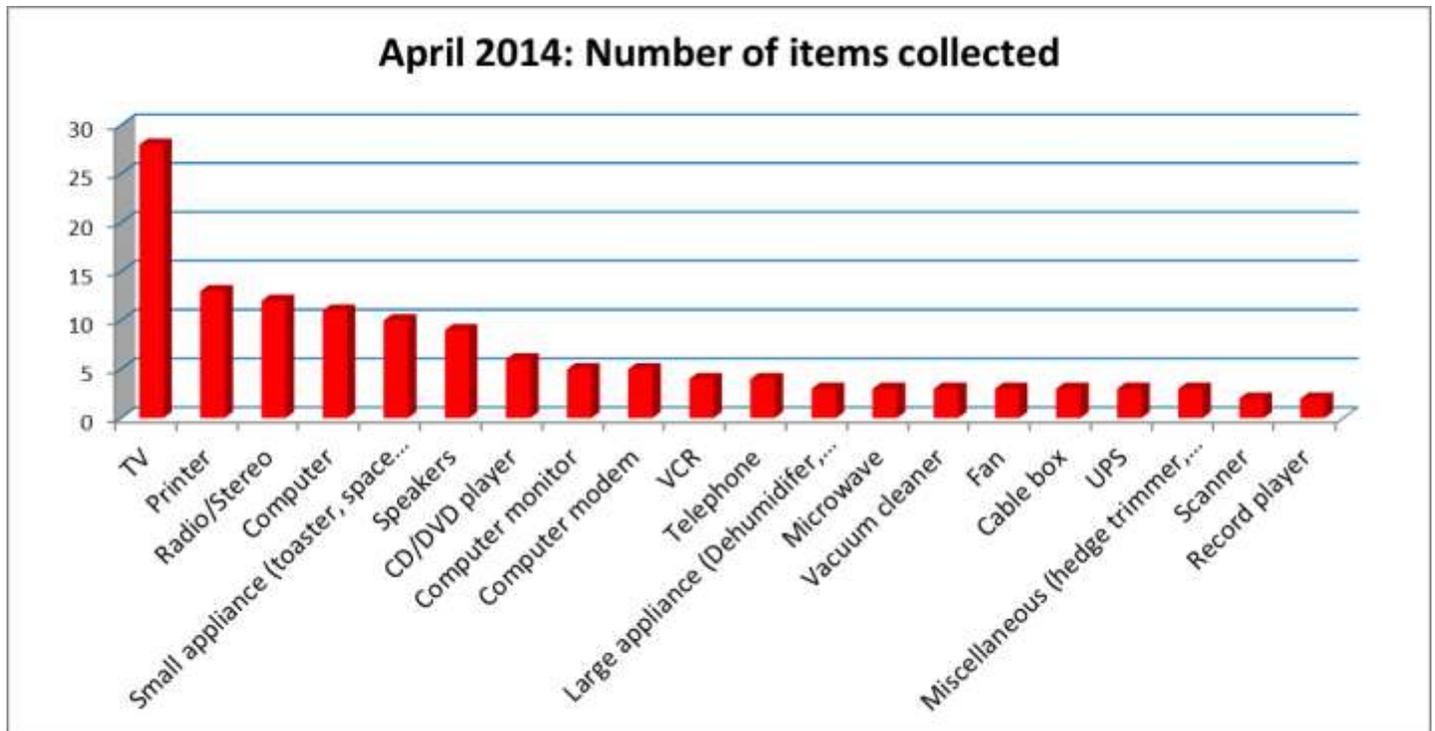


South Nyack residents Paul and Kathy Tappenden wheeled over their items to be added to the growing pile.
