Meeting called to order by Mayor Christian at 6:01pm.

Mayor Christian opened public session at 6:01pm. No comments from the public. Mayor Christian closed public session at 6:01pm.

Minutes:

Upon a motion by Mayor Lynn, seconded by Trustee Abrams, the minutes of the Joint Police Board meeting of 01/26/21 were adopted 4-0 as Trustee Lockett was excused during the approval.

Old Business:

1. Discussion of Executive Order 203: Chief Wilson reported the EO 203 Stakeholder Committee for SNGVPD will have a meeting on February 24, 2021 at 6:00pm. Dr Connally from the Nyack School District will give a presentation on implicit bias followed by Q&A period. The EO 203 finalized plan deadline is April 1, 2021 for submission to the Budget Office of New York State. The Mental Health Committee of the Rockland County Coalition to End the New Jim Crow gave a presentation on January 20, 2021. EO 203 Stakeholder Mark Dery requested to meet with SNGVPD personnel in the near future. Discussion of requesting deadline extension beyond April 1, 2021. Funding from NYS may be restricted if deadline is not met. Governor's Executive

Budget 2022 proposes assigning a representative from NYS to municipalities that do not meet deadline at the expense of the municipality. Wilson reports all other Rockland County Law Enforcement agencies confident to meet April 1, 2021 deadline.

2. Chief Wilson provided update on relevant past/future training for SNGVPD: 02/17/21 DCJS webinar "Working with individuals in distress and ways to increase officer wellness"; Fall of 2021 Montefiore Hospital is hosting "Mental health first aid training"; In-service Day 1 at Rockland County Police Academy "Procedural Justice".
3. Discussion of YouTube video by Emmanuel Acho "Uncomfortable Conversations with a Black Man" episode #9 "A Conversation With the Police".

New Business:

1. Chief Wilson reported SNGVPD General Order #313-Use of Force required a revision to include the prohibition of chokeholds following a Presidential Executive Order in 2020. Trustee McCue made a motion to adopt revised GO #313. Seconded by Trustee Abrams. Passed unanimously. Revised GO #313 will be posted on Village of South Nyack website. Wilson reported In-service training provides annual refresher of NYS Penal Law Article 35.
2. Discussion of proposed 2021-2022 SNGVPD budget postponed to future JPB meeting.


Mayor Christian made a motion to enter Executive Session at 6:43pm for a personnel matter. Seconded by Trustee Lockett. Passed unanimously.
