Pursuant to the Notice of Publication in the Rockland Journal News on September 3, 2019, following the pledge, a public hearing was called to order by Mayor Christian at 7:31pm to elicit public comment regarding a proposed local law related to the Use of the Village-Owned Tennis Court. Mayor Christian read aloud the proposed local law. Mayor Christian invited comments from the public. Kevin Pariseau inquired about what restrictions will be on the use of the new tennis court. Mayor Christian commented that the tennis court will be open upon the proposed local law being adopted and filed with the State; along with the installation of a new sign on the fence surrounding the tennis court. Deputy Mayor Leinbach stated that the cost of the new tennis court was \$78,190 which was funded through the New York State Thruway Authority's Waterfront Revitalization Project.

At 7:38pm, upon motion made by Mayor Christian, seconded by Trustee McCue and carried, the Public Hearing was closed.
