Mayor Christian opened public session at 6:31pm. No comments from the public. Mayor Christian closed public session at 6:31pm.

Minutes:

Upon a motion by Mayor Christian, seconded by Trustee Lockett, the minutes of the Joint Police Board meeting of 04/27/21 were adopted unanimously.

Old Business:

1. Chief Wilson will schedule police personnel to attend the "Getting to the Root" training hosted by the Center for Safety and Change. The training is a 2-day training that is offered once per month. There are sessions planned the remainder of the calendar year.

New Business:

1. Chief Wilson reported no issues within the parks of South Nyack.
2. Chief Wilson reported the bicyclist population is normal. Selective enforcement is occurring during favorable riding conditions.


Mayor Christian closed public session at 6:53pm.
